1. Create a careerCONNECT account using your myUmanitoba email at:

2. Complete this form and email it, along with a pdf of your resume and current web transcript to: elizabeth.barros@cs.umanitoba.ca **DEADLINE: FRIDAY, APRIL 17TH**
3. If you satisfy the eligibility criteria, you will be contacted by the Co-op Office and invited for an intake interview, which will be conducted remotely. Dates for intake interviews are yet to be determined.
4. Upon completion of your intake interview, you will be given access to an online application in careerCONNECT which you will complete as the final step in the process.
5. At the end of August 2020, you will receive an e-mail advising whether or not you've been accepted to CS Co-op Program, as well as info concerning next steps.
